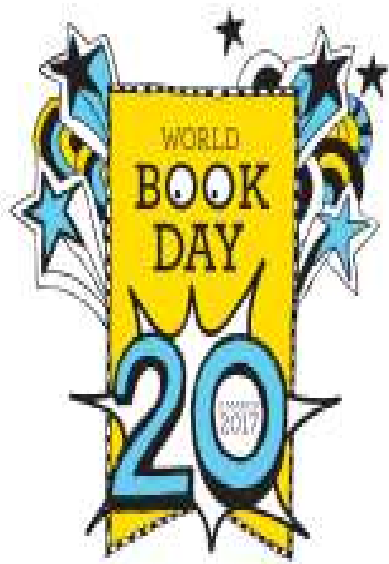


## World Book Day Thursday March 2nd
